

CampusCard – how to pay in the Mensa

If you want to eat in the cafeteria (Mensa), you need a CampusCard. The CampusCard is a rechargeable chip card for cashless payment which allows you to eat and drink at any of the cafeterias and cafés run by the Studentenwerk Heidelberg (student services organisation). It is not possible to pay in cash.

You can obtain the CampusCard at the InfoCenter in the Zentralmensa (INF 304) by paying a 5 Euro deposit and the desired recharge amount. You will be refunded the deposit and the amount that is left on it, when you return the CampusCard at the InfoCenter. Please note that the InfoCenter closes at 3 p.m. on Fridays.

You may recharge the card at the recharge machines in the Mensa or at the desk of the InfoCenter. There are also terminals next to the waiting lines where you can check the credit balance. At the recharge machines you can recharge the card with cash (5-, 10-, 20- and 50-Euro-notes) or with your EC or credit card* (amount: 20 or 50 Euros). Only the current credit balance and the card number is stored on the CampusCard, so please note down your card number. If your card gets lost, you can ask by the number whether it has been found.
